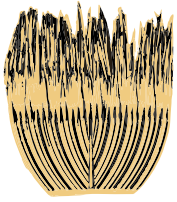
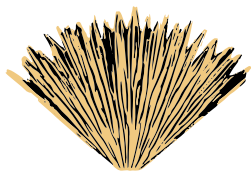


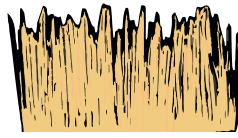

**Starter Strip (1)**

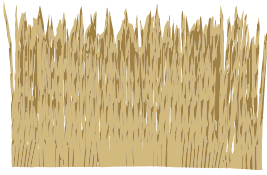

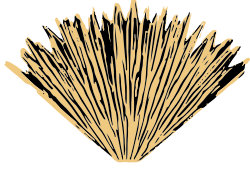

This picture shows 3 rows on battens

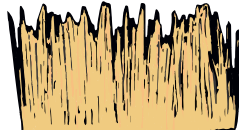

### Doc Palm System TILE SHINGLE INSTALLATION

REFER TO STARTER STRIP ABOVE BEFORE INSTALLING



9" Spacing (1)

Space the tile shingles 9" apart for a closed roof installation



Wrapping (2)

Wrap the tile around the fascia and nail or screw



Tile 2 (3)

Tile shingles butt up to one another.
